Temporary Water Meter Set on Hydrant

Please be reminded that, as part of Bangor Water's hydrant set policy, you are responsible for:

- contacting the District for an appointment to set a water meter, providing an authorized signature for this contract, and paying the sign-up fee (and deposit if required) in advance of the meter set.
- supplying any fittings and hose. Bangor Water will provide a water meter and backflow preventer, ending with a 3/4-inch to two-inch male iron pipe thread as determined by the size of the meter.
- ensuring that the water meter and backflow preventer are in place whenever water is drawn from the hydrant. Should the meter need to be relocated, you must contact the District in order that BWD personnel perform the relocation (for a charge). **Non-District personnel are not permitted to operate hydrants or relocate meter sets.**
- ensuring that water is drawn from the hydrant in a manner appropriate to minimize pressure loss and discolored water to adjacent customers.
- **ensuring that the meter, backflow preventer, and hydrant are not stolen or damaged due to vandalism, freezing temperatures, improper operation, etc. You will be billed for any damage incurred; please take steps to secure and lock access to the hydrant set, and protect it from freezing.**
- notifying us in advance when you no longer need the hydrant set so we can remove it. The meter will automatically removed on or about Oct. 15 unless other arrangements are made.
- paying the bills (based on rates approved by the Maine Public Utilities Commission) issued monthly by Bangor Water for the meter and the amount of water used by the due date. Failure to do so may result in removal of the meter without notice. Sales tax is charged unless a sales tax exemption certificate is returned with this application. (Non-profit organizations or businesses with resale certificates are not sales tax exempt unless they have a sales tax exemption number.)
- obtaining permission from the property owner for use of the hydrant, if a private hydrant.

Bangor Water is not responsible for the condition of the water once it passes from the hydrant, including suitability for potable uses.
