

Projects on the Drawing Board for 2019

Pipe Improvements

Union Street (West Broadway to I-95) and Fourteenth Street (Ohio to Union)

- Replace 1910 and 1912 cast iron mains.
- Area of several leaks. City plans to pave.
- Estimated costs: \$1.9 million

State, Spruce and Hancock streets

- Replace 1911 main (key supply to hospital)
- Joint project with City sewer, prior to paving.
- Estimate cost: \$825,000

Parker Street (between Third and Fifth streets)

- Consolidate remaining service lines to newer main. City planning sewer work and potential paving.
- Estimated cost: \$100,000

Facility Improvements

BIA and Hammond Street pressure zone study

- Next phase of evaluating growth potential, operational flexibility, fire flows, and system redundancy before replacement/elimination of 1944 and 1963 standpipes and 1943 pump station.

Ozone treatment plant (1995) upgrade—Phase II

- Finalization of plant design and installation of new ozone components.
- Estimated cost: \$2.3 million

Thomas Hill Standpipe

- Replace promenade deck flooring.
