## POSITION DESCRIPTION

**JOB TITLE:** Maintenance Technician

**DEPT:** Maintenance

**JOB TYPE:** Full-time employee, Hourly

Wage range is \$21 to \$28 per hour depending on qualifications and experience
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**GENERAL DESCRIPTION:** Serves as Maintenance Worker providing a broad range of maintenance support. Working outside of normal working hours may be required.

### **DUTIES:**

Assists the Maintenance Supervisor with the following duties:

- Vehicle and fleet equipment repair
- Preventative maintenance, repairs and cleaning on District facilities
- Chloramination monitoring and dosing at rechloramination facilities as required.
- Corrosion control monitoring and dosing at the Griffin Road Facility
- Preventative maintenance and diagnostics on selected electrical and electronic systems.
- Maintains and updates daily log of repairs, inspections, and preventive maintenance as required.

Serves on regular rotation for weekly on-call coverage as directed or required. Responds for emergency duty as required.

Attends safety, training, and other department meetings as required.

Performs other related duties as required.

### **REQUIREMENTS:**

**Education:** High school diploma or equivalent required.

**Experience:** Experience in waterworks, construction, maintenance preferred.

**Licenses:** Possess or obtain within two years of hire a State of Maine operator licenses for a Class II Water Treatment System and a Class II Distribution System. Maine Class A driver's license required within 18 months of hire. Obtain a Tank Smart A/B Operator license within 6 months of hire.

### **Skills and Knowledge:**

Working knowledge of distribution and plant operations, and ability to perform both emergency and routine inspections and repair of equipment, machinery, and vehicles.

Demonstrated computer proficiency at operating PC/server-based systems. Must possess working knowledge of electronic spreadsheets and databases and GIS software.

Working knowledge of standard methods of repair, and proper tools and equipment used in the welding process, including AC/DC welders, torches, and related equipment.

Ability to climb standpipes in excess of 100 feet high and to work in confined spaces, while observing applicable safety precautions.

Knowledge of applicable safety precautions and procedures in using a variety of repair and construction equipment and related hand tools.

Ability to read and interpret blueprints, electrical multimeters, and technical manuals.

Willingness to cross-train in all aspects of the water utility profession.

**RESPONSIBILITIES:**

Performs a variety of relatively regular and standard duties according to the established practices, precedents, and procedures of the department, using personal judgment and taking action to determine and implement the best approaches and methods to use.

Responsibilities will include, but not necessarily be limited to:

- Vehicle, equipment and building maintenance

**WORK ENVIRONMENT:**

Performs duties in both office and field settings. Periodically exposed to noise, grease, dirt, high voltage, various gases and hazardous chemicals. Safety precautions must be observed at all times to ensure personal safety and safety of others.

**ADDITIONAL JOB REQUIREMENTS:**

Ability to: legally operate assigned District vehicles; work in accordance with safe procedures and the District's safety program, including in confined spaces; perform manual labor; safely operate various small hand and power tools; ability to lift 50 pounds; respond to emergencies at all hours and in all weather conditions; learn CPR and First Aid; live within 30 miles of the Bangor city limits; serve on weekly on-call rotation; and communicate with co-workers, vendors, and members of the public in a courteous and effective manner.
